

USGA Rules of Golf shall govern all play except as modified by local rule as follows:

1. OUT OF BOUNDS – defined by white stakes. In course out of bounds on holes #9 and #18 apply only to balls played from the teeing ground.
2. WATER HAZARDS – defined by yellow stakes and/or lines.
 - a. Hole #15 – Any ball crossing the water hazard and coming to rest left of the lateral hazard is deemed to be in the water hazard and players must use the designated drop area.
3. LATERAL HAZARDS – defined by red stakes and/or lines.
 - a. Water hazard on hole #7 is deemed to be a lateral hazard during the play of hole #6.
 - b. Holes #9 and #17 – Any ball coming to rest left of the hazard is deemed to be in the hazard. The ball must be dropped within two club lengths of the point where it last crossed the right margin of the hazard or played from the previous spot. As an additional option on hole #9, players may utilize the drop area if it is indeterminable where the ball last crossed the margin of the hazard.
4. GROUND UNDER REPAIR – defined by white lines. All flowerbeds are deemed ground under repair from which play is prohibited.
5. OBSTRUCTIONS – plastic tubing and wraps around trees are deemed integral parts of the course and relief is **NOT** available. All open spillways are deemed integral parts of the golf course and relief is **NOT** available. All paths (paved and unpaved) are considered obstructions and relief is available.

All distances are measured to middle of green.
Fairway yardage posts are 150 yards to center of green.
